*** William Henry Harrison**

William Henry Harrison was Territorial Governor of Indiana when the War of 1812 began. In 1813 he assumed command of the Army of the Northwest and ordered the construction of Fort Meigs. General Harrison commanded Fort Meigs during the first British siege of the fort in May, 1813. William Henry Harrison remained in politics after the war and became the ninth president of the United States of America.

**** Captain Eleazor D. Wood**

Captain Eleazor D. Wood, an early graduate of West Point and a member of the U.S. Corps of Engineers, helped to layout and oversee the construction of Fort Meigs. Today, Fort Meigs stands in Wood County, Ohio, named in honor of Captain Wood.

Return Jonathan Meigs

Fort Meigs, built in February 1813 was named after then Ohio governor Return Jonathan Meigs. The fort withstood two British sieges in 1813 and helped turn the tide of war in favor of the U.S. military.
