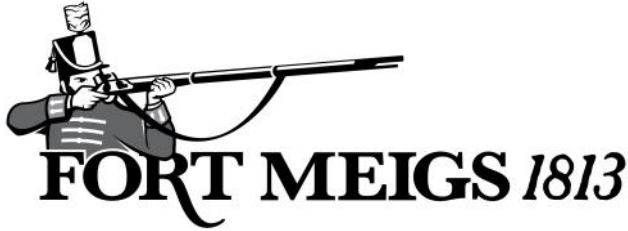


Fort Meigs presents

Spinning fibers into yarn is an ancient trade. Now you can learn to spin in this fun workshop taught by Susan Cayton, a long-time Fort Meigs volunteer. Participants learn how to prepare fibers, use a wooden drop spindle, and try several different makes of spinning wheels. Those with their own spinning wheels in good working order are welcome to bring them to share.
